5. Must present a brief resume of the girl's background and activities, plus a billfold size picture to chairman of the Miss Cass County Contest by July 12.
6. The contestants must be present on the day of the contest for the interview and that same night for the pageant and appear in the parade.
7. Miss Cass County will help distribute ribbons and help as needed.
