CASS COUNTY FAIR TUFF TRUCK & CAR RULES

- 1.Registration for the event will be the day of the event and check in will begin at 6:30 P.M.
- 2. Registration fee will be \$25.00 per driver and that amount is required when you register.
- 3. Driver and pit crew members must be at least 16 years old. Each driver may enter only 1 time per class. Driver must have a valid state driver's license.
- 4. All contestants and pit crew members must sign a waiver understanding that they are competing at their own risk and that they will not bring suit against any officials, employees, event sponsors or the Dodge County Fair Association. By signing the release form you agree to all rules set forth.
- 5. Cass County Fair/Get Bent Promotions officials have the right to approve or reject any or all entry applications.
- 6. All drivers must attend the driver's meeting 30 minutes prior to the start of the Demo.
- 7. A vehicle may be disqualified for either emotional or physical reasons by Competition Director or track officials. Example: Drugs or drinking alcoholic beverages. (Any driver or any of his or her pit crew consuming an intoxicating agent, and/or drugs, prior to or during the event will be disqualified from the event. Drivers will be held responsible for the actions of their crew).
- 8. If any vehicle and/or driver is disqualified for any reason, no payout of prize winnings will occur for that competitor.
- 9. Competition vehicles must be operated in a safe manner before, during and after the event while on the fairgrounds. Track officials have the right to stop and disqualify any vehicle being operated in a reckless manner
- 10. Competitors must wait for the starting signal from the Starter Flagman before starting their runs. All competitors must stop between two designated cones at the end of the run, failure to stop between the cones means the run does not count.
- 11. Only the driver will be allowed in the vehicle when it is being towed or driven in the pit area, staging area, or track. No riders in or on any vehicle while in the pit area, staging area, or in the track area.
- 12. When a Competition vehicle's engine is running, a competent driver must be in the driver's seat. No exceptions. Automatic disqualification for violation.
- 13. Track officials will have the option to check competitor's vehicles for rule violations at any time; prior to, during, or after the event.
- 14. All contestants must drive the vehicle onto track and into position to compete under its own power and must leave track under its own power unless for breakage.
- 15. No one was allowed on the track except for track officials and contestants.
- 16. Seat belts (both lap belts and shoulder strap) required and must be worn.

- 17. Windshield is optional but the way it comes in the gate is the way it is going to run, not taking the windshield out while in the pits.
- 18. Drivers must wear a full-face helmet. Helmet strap must be fastened. Fire retardant jackets and pants, shoes and gloves are HIGHLY recommended but not required.
- 19. Battery must be securely mounted!!!!
- 20. No loose objects in the cab or any place else in the vehicle.
- 21. All pick-up truck beds must be firmly attached to the chassis. Tailgates must be securely fastened or removed. If the hood is bolted down, there must be a hole in the hood that measures at least 8" in diameter above the carburetor. If the hood becomes dislodged and is blocking the vision of the driver during the event, the vehicle must stop at that location. Any deviation from this is cause for disqualification.
- 22. All contestants are responsible for disabling all airbags in their vehicle if so equipped.
