

Special Contests for 2023 Cass County Fair

LEGO DESIGNER CONTEST

Thursday and Friday, in the Commercial Building. Teams or Individual

2:30-3:30pm - Building Legos

3:30-4:00pm - Judging of Legos

Ages 6 & under, Ages 7-12, and Ages 13 & up

Winners of each group will return on **Saturday, August 12 at 4:00pm for final judging.**

Grand Champion: \$20 and Ribbon

Reserve Champion: \$10.00

Third Place: \$5.00

POTHOLDER PROJECT

Enter on Sunday, August 6 between 4:00 and 6:00pm in the Expo Center.

Make 2 potholders to be 6" to 10" and can be any shape. Fabric should be 100% quilt quality cotton. Batting should be 2 layers of cotton or wool, or 1 layer of cotton batting plus 1 layer of insulation, such as Insul-Bright. Include a hanging loop or ring. If you wish, you may leave your potholders to be donated to the National Quilt Museum in Lincoln, to be sold in their gift shop.



Reuse, Recycle, Repurpose

Special Contest with purpose to utilize things normally discarded to landfills, etc, to repurpose or reuse in a new way. Enter items Sunday, Aug. 6, 4-6pm in Commercial Building, where they will be judged and displayed in conjunction with Keep Cass County Beautiful and Friends of the Fair.

BEST TASTING TOMATO IN CASS COUNTY

During intermission of Miss Cass County Contest on Wednesday evening. Check in around 7:30pm east side of Open Air by the Frontier stand.

Class 1: Heirloom (enter 2)

Class 2: Slicing (enter 2)

Class 3: Grape (enter 6)

Class 4: Roma (enter 4)

Class 5: Other (enter 2)

1st Prize - Grand Champion and Cup and \$100

2nd Prize - Reserve Champion and \$50

3rd Prize - Purple Ribbon and \$25

Tomato will be cut and eaten! If contest takes longer than intermission, we will resume after the crowning of Miss Cass County.

Special Quilt Block Contest

This year the special quilt block contest is for a block made of traditional red/white/blue patriotic colors, and measures 12 1/2" square. Enter as many as you want; just be sure they are each a different pattern.



It has been decided that a quilt will no longer be made from the quilt block contest entries for raffle the following year. Quilters are invited to donate their block(s) to become a group of blocks to be put up for silent auction for the buyer to put together into their own patriotic quilt. There will be a paper

near the quilt block display for anyone interested to write down their bid. Just sign your name and bid, and monitor the bids as the fair progresses. Highest bid at 8:30 on Saturday night wins the collection. Winner will settle up as the displays are dismantled on Saturday night.
